GOD IS GOOD! By God's grace, I just returned from my eighth trip to Uganda last week with three pastor friends. What we saw was amazing...I wish you all could have been there with us!

PRIMARY SCHOOL

The basic structure of our new facility is completed with three stories and a roof. Just look at these pictures and see all that God has done in the last six years... yes the kids were meeting in this wood structure. without two daily meals, and the high quality of education they are receiving now. We just moved into the new facility the last week of February!



THE CHURCH: God's hand is evident through the people of Restoration Assembly Church. Frank continues to raise up leaders, preach the gospel on the radio, run an orphanage. and strongly impact the local community through the school. Hellen is mentoring hundreds of women and appears regularly on a local television show. You can also witness God's hand at work in the progress of their facility. They began on rented land (2011), built on



purchased land (2012), began construction on the permanent building (2014) and are now inside the "open air conditioned" facility!





BOARDING SECTION: One of the most exciting things has been the launch of our primary boarding section. Up to 24 children can live in our facility right between the church and school for 9 months a year. They are being fed, clothed, loved, educated, and discipled by the church. Here is Sarah Nalubega who was born HIV+ and 8 years ago came to our orphanage in the children's

village. She is now in our boarding section and an actively involved in church as well as receiving a great education in the primary 7 class of our school.

<u>AMAZING ACADEMICS</u> Restoration Primary School continues to perform at the highest standards of academics in Uganda. In the past five years we have had 29 "first grades" and 37 "second grades" on our national exams.

Only 6% of students nationwide received a first grade and almost half of our students have performed at this level. This is Hanifa Nalukenge who received first а grade 4 years ago, and then received another 4 years later after Secondary School. Her high scores have opened the door for an opportunity to become а pharmacist through "head start" а program at Makerere University.



TAX RETURN? As
